

## **2011 Summer Dance Camp Guidelines and General Information**

### **Dates, Times, & Fees:**

- Mini Dance Camp for 5-7 y/o  
July 5-8<sup>th</sup> 9-12AM (\$140 before April 1<sup>st</sup>; \$155 after April 1<sup>st</sup> )  
July 25-29<sup>th</sup> 9-12AM (\$180 before April 1<sup>st</sup> \$195 after April 1<sup>st</sup> )
- Luna Kids Dance Camp for 8-11 y/o  
June 27-July 1<sup>st</sup> 9AM – 3PM  
August 1-5<sup>th</sup> 9AM – 3PM  
Before April 1<sup>st</sup>: \$250 per week; \$490 for both weeks  
After April 1<sup>st</sup>: \$285 per week \$560 for both weeks
- Teen Choreography Workshop for 12-17 y/o  
July 11-15<sup>th</sup> 10AM – 4PM  
July 18-22<sup>nd</sup> 10AM – 4PM  
Before April 1<sup>st</sup>: \$250 a week; \$490 for both weeks  
After April 1<sup>st</sup>: \$285 a week; \$560 for both weeks  
July 25-29<sup>th</sup> 9AM-4PM Teaching Lab by application only (NO FEE)

**Payment & Refund Policy:** A non-refundable, non-transferable deposit of \$100 per week is required to secure a spot in all camps. Students are encouraged to register early as enrollment is limited. The tuition balance is due in full by Monday, June 21st. Refunds are available minus the \$100 per week deposit on or before June 21st. After June 21st, no refunds will be given unless due to illness or injury that prohibits participation.

**Observation:** Parents are invited to watch on the last day – speak with teacher about times.

**Attire:** We suggest comfortable, loose clothing. Bare feet are required.

**Punctuality:** Entering a huge dance room once a class is already in progress can be scary for young children. Timely arrival will help make your child's transition easier. **All students must be picked up on time.**

**Non-smoking policy:** Smoking is prohibited within a 15-foot perimeter. To file a complaint, contact the Alameda County Public Health Department Tobacco Control Program at (510) 628-STOP.

**Site-specific rules:** Please keep your children under your supervision and in designated waiting areas until the teacher brings them into the dance space. **No eating, drinking or shoes are allowed in the dance space.**
